## Investment Strategy

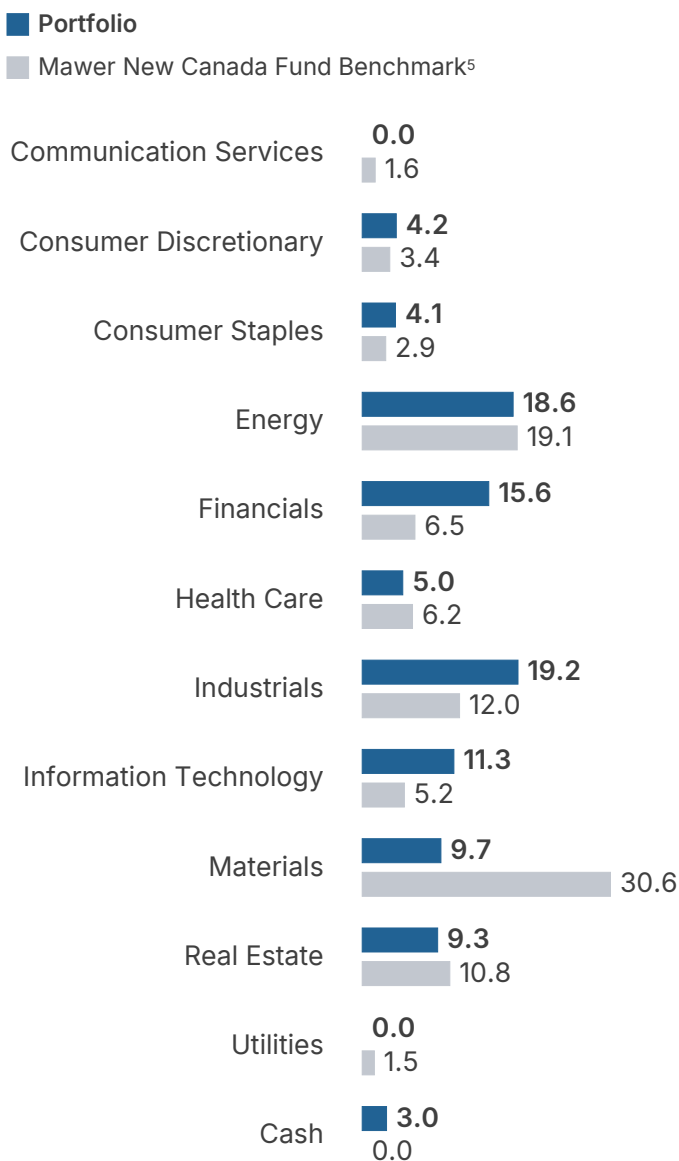
